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SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

October

On July 19, 1995 in San Francisco, California, As You Sow ("AYS") and 'D' Aircraft Products, Inc. ("'D' Aircraft") agreed to the following terms and condition:

WHEREAS:

AYS is a not-for-profit public interest foundation dedicated to promoting consumer awareness, protecting the environment and improving human health; and

'D' Aircraft is a California company that currently manufactures and distributes aerospace performance materials, including sealants, conformal coatings, adhesives, primers, epoxies, calendared sheet rubber, and chemical milling materials, some of which contain chemicals listed as known to the State of California to cause cancer and/or birth defects or other harm, pursuant to Health & Safety Code §25249.8 ("Proposition 65"), including but not limited to toluene; and

On January 1, 1991, toluene was officially listed by the State of California as a chemical known to cause birth defects or other reproductive harm, pursuant to Health & Safety Code §25249.8; and

A list of the products containing Proposition 65-listed chemicals which are covered by this Agreement is provided in Exhibit A (the "Products"). The Products have been distributed by 'D' Aircraft for sale and/or use in California since February 28, 1988; and

On August 25, 1994, AYS served 'D' Aircraft with a document entitled "60-Day Notice" which provided 'D' Aircraft with notice that it was allegedly in violation of Health & Safety Code §25249.6 for failing to warn purchasers that certain products it distributes for sale and/or use in California expose users to Proposition 65-listed chemicals; and

On June 20, 1995, AYS filed a complaint entitled As You Sow v. 'D' Aircraft Products, Inc. (No. 164409) in Marin County Superior Court, naming 'D' Aircraft as a defendant and alleging violations of Business & Professions Code §17200 and Health & Safety Code §25249.6 on behalf of individuals in California who allegedly are exposed to Proposition 65-listed chemicals including toluene in certain 'D' Aircraft products;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE PARTIES AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1. PRODUCT LABELING. Beginning immediately, 'D' Aircraft shall initiate revisions to its current labels for the Products. 'D' Aircraft agrees that as of December 31, 1995, it shall not ship (or cause to be shipped) any of the Products for sale or use in the State of California unless each such Product contains one of the following warning statements on its label:

- 1.1. For Products containing a chemical listed by the State of California as known to cause birth defects or other reproductive harm:
 - "Contains chemical(s) known to the State of California to cause reproductive toxicity."
- 1.2. For Products containing a chemical listed by the State of California as known to cause cancer:
 - "Contains chemical(s) known to the State of California to cause cancer."
- 1.3. For Products containing any combination of chemicals listed by the State of California as known to cause cancer and known to cause birth defects or other reproductive harm:
 - "Contains chemical(s) known to the State of California to cause cancer and reproductive toxicity."
- 1.4. This warning statement shall be prominent and displayed with such conspicuousness, as compared with other words, statements, or designs as to render it likely to be read and understood by an ordinary individual. An example of such a label is attached hereto as Exhibit B.
- 2. MSDS REVISIONS. Beginning immediately, 'D' Aircraft will initiate revisions to its current MSDSs for the Products so that the warning or warnings will be consistent in wording with the on-label warning language required by ¶1. Final printed MSDSs incorporating the revised warnings will being to be distributed in the normal course of business but in any event no later than December 31, 1995. An example of such an MSDS is attached as Exhibit C.
- 3. SETTLEMENT AMOUNT.
 - 3.1 Restitution and Investigation Costs. 'D' Aircraft agrees to pay \$11,270 to AYS upon execution of this Agreement. The restitutionary component of this amount, made pursuant to Business & Professions Code \$17203, shall be transferred to The Data Center located in Oakland. The cost component of this payment will be used by AYS to help defray its investigation fees and costs, expert fees, reasonable attorneys' fees, and any other costs incurred as a result of investigating, bringing this matter to 'D' Aircraft's attention, litigating and negotiating a settlement in the public interest.
- 4. AYS RELEASE. AYS, by this Agreement, waives all rights to institute action against 'D' Aircraft, its distributors or retailers which sell the Products listed on Exhibit A, and its customers who use these Products and their respective employees,

officers, directors, attorneys or representatives, whether under Proposition 65, Business & Profession Code §§17200 et seq., or any other statute or common law claim based on 'D' Aircraft's failure to warn users about exposure to Proposition 65 chemicals.

- 5. 'D' AIRCRAFT RELEASE. 'D' Aircraft, by this Agreement, waives all rights to institute any form of legal action against AYS, its members, officers, directors, attorneys and representatives (the "AYS Releasees") based on any statute or provision of common law and for all actions or statements made by the AYS Releasees in the course of seeking enforcement of Proposition 65 against 'D' Aircraft.
- 6. STIPULATED JUDGMENT. The parties shall file a stipulated judgment to be approved pursuant to CCP §664.6 by the Marin County Superior Court in accordance with the terms of this agreement.
- 7. UNENFORCEABILITY. In the event that any of the provisions of this Agreement are held by a court to be unenforceable, the validity of the enforceable provisions shall not be adversely affected.
- 8. GOVERNING LAW. The terms of this Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of California.
- 9. CORRESPONDENCE.

- 10. NO ADMISSION. Nothing in this Agreement shall be construed as an admission by 'D' Aircraft of any fact, finding, issue of law, or violation of law, nor shall compliance with this Agreement constitute or be construed as an admission by 'D' Aircraft of any fact, finding, conclusion, issue of law, or violation of law. However, this paragraph shall not diminish or otherwise affect the obligation, responsibilities, and duties of 'D' Aircraft under this Agreement.
- 11. AUTHORITY TO EXECUTE. The undersigned are authorized to execute this Agreement on behalf of their respective parties and have read, understood and agree to all of the terms and conditions of this Agreement.
