SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

This Settlement Agreement (this "Agreement") is entered into by and between As You Sow, a California nonprofit corporation ("AYS") and The Valspar Corporation, a Delaware corporation ("VALSPAR"), as of June 26, 1996 (the "Effective Date").

WHEREAS:

AYS is a not-for-profit public interest foundation dedicated to promoting consumer and employee awareness, protecting the environment and improving human health;

VALSPAR is a corporation headquartered in Minnesota that manufactures and distributes, on its own and through its subsidiaries, paints and coatings in the State of California that contain Proposition 65-listed chemicals;

A list of the categories of products that contain toluene, benzene, crystalline silica, lead, and other Proposition 65-listed chemicals and which are covered by this Agreement is provided in Exhibit A (the "Products");

Some of the Products have been distributed and sold by VALSPAR for use in California since February 27, 1988;

On August 25, 1994, AYS first served Sunbelt Coatings, Inc., a subsidiary of VALSPAR, and the appropriate public enforcement agencies with a document entitled "60-Day Notice" which provided Sunbelt Coatings, Inc. with notice that it was allegedly in violation of Health & Safety Code §25249.6 for failing to warn purchasers that certain products it sells in California expose users to listed carcinogens and reproductive toxins such as toluene; and

On August 10, 1995, AYS served VALSPAR and the appropriate public enforcement agencies with a second "60-Day Notice" which provided VALSPAR with notice that it was allegedly in violation of Health & Safety Code §25249.6 for failing to warn purchasers that certain other products it sells in California expose users to toluene, benzene, crystalline silica and lead.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE PARTIES AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1. Labeling. VALSPAR agrees that as of June 1, 1997, it shall not ship (or cause to be shipped) any of the Products for sale or use in the State of California unless each such

"WARNING: This product contains chemicals known to the State of California to cause cancer."

For Products (other than Sunbelt Coatings, Inc. Products) containing both a Proposition 65 chemical listed by the State of California as known to cause cancer and a Proposition 65 chemical listed by the State of California as known to cause birth defects or other reproductive harm in amounts exceeding the "no significant risk" and "no

observable effect" level as each such term is applicable and as each is defined in Health & Safety Code § 25249.10(c):

"WARNING: This product contains chemicals known to the State of California to cause cancer and birth defects or other reproductive harm."

For Sunbelt Coatings, Inc. Products containing one or more Proposition 65 chemicals listed by the State of California as known to cause birth defects or other reproductive harm in amounts exceeding the "no observable effect" level as such term is defined in Health and Safety Code § 25249.10(c):

"WARNING: This product contains a chemical(s) known to the State of California to cause birth defects or other reproductive harm."

For Sunbelt Coatings, Inc. Products containing one or more Proposition 65 chemicals listed by the State of California as known to cause cancer in amounts exceeding the "no significant risk" level as such term is defined in Health & Safety Code § 25249.10(c) the product labels shall contain the following warning:

"WARNING: This product contains a chemical(s) known to the State of California to cause cancer."

For Sunbelt Coatings, Inc. Products containing both a Proposition 65 chemical listed by the State of California as known to cause cancer and a Proposition 65 chemical listed by the State of California as known to cause birth defects or other reproductive harm in amounts exceeding the "no significant risk" and "no observable effect" level as each such term is applicable and as each is defined in Health & Safety Code § 25249.10(c) the product labels shall contain both of the following warnings:

"WARNING: This product contains a chemical(s) known to the State of California to cause birth defects or other reproductive harm."

"WARNING: This product contains a chemical(s) known to the State of California to cause cancer."

This warning statement shall be prominent and displayed with such conspicuousness, as compared with other words, statements, or

designs as to render it likely to be read and understood by an ordinary individual. The parties agree that the sample label attached hereto as Exhibit B satisfies this requirement.

- 2. Warnings For Products in Commerce. VALSPAR agrees that on or before September 1, 1996, it shall provide warning materials by certified mail to the customers that VALSPAR knows or has reason to believe sell, distribute or use the Products in California in an effort to ensure that users receive Proposition 65 warnings for Products that have not been labelled in accordance with Section 1 hereof. Such warning materials shall include a reasonably sufficient number of warning stickers reflecting the appropriate warning statement as set forth in Section 1 hereof (considering the size of each particular customer and the amount of Products each customer has purchased), and a letter of instruction for the placement of the stickers. A sample of these materials is attached hereto as Exhibit C.
- Restitution and Costs. VALSPAR agrees to pay \$85,000 to AYS upon execution of this Agreement. The restitutionary component of this payment is \$40,250 and shall be made pursuant to Business & Professions Code §17203, and shall be forwarded by AYS to the Environmental Law and Justice Clinic ("ELJC"), Sierra Club Legal Defense Fund ("SCLDF"), Earth Day Network ("EDN"), and Pacific Environment & Resources Center ("PERC"). ELJC seeks assistance in litigation over toxic discharges into the San Francisco Bay. SCLDF is a litigation group specializing in enforcement of environmental laws. EDN operates a national Earth Day Education Program and strives to distribute environmental materials in schools throughout the PERC works to empower citizen efforts to protect the The cost component of this payment is \$44,750, and environment. will be used by AYS to help defray its investigation fees and costs, expert fees, reasonable attorneys' fees, and any other costs incurred as a result of investigating, bringing this matter to VALSPAR's attention, litigating and negotiating a settlement in the public interest.
- §25249.7(b), VALSPAR shall pay a civil penalty of \$190,000. Such payment will be due on June 1, 1997. Penalty monies shall be apportioned by AYS in accordance with Health & Safety Code \$25192. This civil penalty may be reduced by one dollar for every two dollars that VALSPAR expends during the period May 15, 1996 through May 15, 1997, in research and development to eliminate (or significantly reduce) the amount of solvents listed pursuant to Proposition 65 in the products manufactured by VALSPAR and sold into the State of California. Therefore, if during such period VALSPAR expends \$380,000 for such research and development, the entire civil penalty shall be waived. Valspar shall provide AYS with an internal accounting of research and development expenditures made pursuant to this Section by June 1,

- 1997. VALSPAR warrants that prior to this Agreement it had not allocated any funds for the period May 15, 1996 through May 15, 1997, for research and development to eliminate (or significantly reduce) the amount of solvents listed pursuant to Proposition 65 in the products manufactured by Valspar and sold into the State of California.
- 5. AYS Release. AYS and its attorneys, employees, successors, and assigns, by this Agreement, waive all rights to institute action against VALSPAR and its distributors, retailers, users, and customers of Products, as well as each of their respective successors, subsidiaries, assigns, attorneys, officers, directors, employees, predecessors, agents, and stockholders, under Proposition 65 or Business & Profession Code §§17200 et seq., as it relates to Proposition 65, based on VALSPAR's failure to warn about exposure to toluene, benzene, crystalline silica, lead, and other Proposition 65-listed chemicals contained in any of the Products listed on Exhibit A of this Agreement. AYS acknowledges that compliance with the terms of this Agreement with respect to the Products shall constitute compliance with Proposition 65 by VALSPAR.
- 6. VALSPAR Release. VALSPAR, by this Agreement, waives all rights to institute action against AYS, its members, officers, directors, attorneys and representatives (the "AYS Releasees") based on any statute or provision of common law and for all actions or statements made by the AYS Releasees in the course of seeking enforcement of Proposition 65 or Business & Profession Code §§17200 et seq. as it relates to Proposition 65 against VALSPAR with respect to the Products.
- 7. MSDS Revisions. VALSPAR shall ensure that the Material Safety Data Sheets ("MSDS") for each of the Products contains a warning in the Health Hazard section identical in wording with the on-label warning language required by Section 1 hereof. Final MSDSs incorporating the revised warning language will begin to be distributed in the normal course of business on or before June 1, 1997.
- 8. Change In Law. In the event that any law, rule, regulation, or final decision of any legislative, judicial or executive body with jurisdiction becomes effective or is entered, which renders the warnings agreed to under Section 1 of this Agreement unnecessary or inappropriate to comply with applicable laws, VALSPAR, at its option, may cease placing the warnings required under Section 1 on its labels and MSDSs; provided, however, that VALSPAR shall continue to provide any warnings that continue to be required under other applicable laws, rules and regulations. For a period of two (2) years from the date of this Agreement, VALSPAR shall provide AYS thirty (30) days prior written notice of its intent to so limit the warning provisions under Section 1 of this Agreement and shall provide AYS with a

written explanation for the basis of its contention that any new or revised law, rule, regulation or final decision limits or otherwise renders inapplicable the warning provisions of Proposition 65. Notwithstanding the terms of this Section, AYS shall not be required under any circumstances to refund or return any amount paid pursuant to Sections 3 and 4 of this Agreement.

- 9. Stipulated Judgment. The parties shall file a stipulated judgment to be approved pursuant to CCP §664.6 by the Alameda Superior Court in accordance with the terms of this Agreement.
- 10. Severability. In the event that any of the provisions of this Agreement are held by a court to be unenforceable, the validity of the enforceable provisions shall not be adversely affected.
- 11. Attorneys' Fees. In the event that a dispute arises with respect to any provision(s) of this Agreement, the prevailing party shall be entitled to recover costs and reasonable attorneys' fees.
- 12. Governing Law. The terms of this Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of California.
- 13. Notices. All correspondence to AYS shall be mailed to:

Nothing in this Agreement shall be construed as an admission by VALSPAR of any fact, finding, issue of law, or violation of law, nor shall compliance with this Agreement constitute or be construed as an admission by VALSPAR of any fact, finding, conclusion, issue of law, or violation of law. However, this Section shall not diminish or otherwise affect the obligation, responsibilities, and duties of VALSPAR under this Agreement.

- 15. Authorization. The undersigned are authorized to execute this Agreement on behalf of their respective parties and have read, understood and agree to all of the terms and conditions of this Agreement.
- 16. Counterparts. This Agreement may be signed in counterparts and each such signed copy shall be deemed an original.
