[PROPOSED] ORDER APPROVING PROPOSITION 65 SETTLEMENT AND CONSENT JUDGMENT

Plaintiff Anthony E. Held, Ph.D., P.E. and defendants Kiss Nail Products, Inc., and Kiss Products, Inc., have agreed through their respective counsel that judgment be entered in this Proposition 65 action pursuant to the terms of the Consent Judgment executed by the parties and attached to the Judgment as Exhibit 1. After consideration of the papers submitted and the arguments presented, the Court finds that the settlement agreement set forth in the Consent Judgment meets the criteria established by Health and Safety Code section 25249.7, in that:

- the injunctive relief required by the Consent Judgment complies with Proposition
 65;
- 2. the reimbursement of attorneys' fees pursuant to the Consent Judgment is reasonable under California law; and
- 3. based on the criteria set forth in Health and Safety Code section 25249.7(b)(2), the civil penalty required by the Consent Judgment is reasonable.

Accordingly, the Motion for Approval of the Proposition 65 Settlement is GRANTED. **IT IS SO ORDERED.**
